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What Makes Good Stock Footage for Faceless Videos

Before looking at the resources, it helps to understand what types of footage work best in faceless videos.

The most useful clips are usually:

Simple B-roll footage

Examples include:

- people using laptops
- scrolling on phones
- typing or working
- office environments
- technology clips

These work well for videos about:

- online business
- AI tools
- marketing software
- productivity

Abstract or background footage

These clips are useful as visual fillers.

Examples include:

- animated backgrounds
- light effects
- moving patterns
- generic tech animations

They help keep viewers engaged while your voiceover explains something.

Demonstration-style clips

These show someone performing an action such as:

- editing video
- using a computer
- working at a desk
- analysing data

These types of clips can visually reinforce what your script is describing.

Best Free Stock Footage Websites

Below are some of the best resources for downloading high-quality video clips.

Many of these sites allow **commercial use with no attribution required**, but it is always a good idea to check the license terms on each website.

Mixkit

Mixkit is one of the best free stock footage resources available.

The library includes a large number of high-quality clips suitable for marketing and online content.

What makes Mixkit particularly useful is that it also includes:

- video templates

- sound effects
- music tracks

Videvo has one of the largest collections of stock footage available online.

- animated backgrounds
- tech visuals

Best for:

- cinematic B-roll

Vidsplay

Vidsplay is a smaller site but still very useful.

New clips are added regularly, and all videos can be downloaded for free.

Best for:

- background clips

Dareful

Dareful specialises in **high-quality 4K footage**, particularly landscapes and nature scenes.

While the library is smaller than some other sites, the footage quality is excellent.

Best for:

- cinematic visuals
- landscapes
- drone footage

How to Find Good Clips Quickly

When searching for footage, try using keywords related to the topic of your video.

Examples:

- “technology”
- “typing laptop”
- “working computer”
- “digital marketing”
- “startup office”

You will often find multiple clips that can work well with your content.

How to Use Stock Footage Effectively

Stock footage works best when combined with a clear voiceover.

A simple workflow might look like this:

1. Generate your video script
2. Record your voiceover
3. Search for clips that match each section of the script
4. Insert the clips while the narration plays

This approach helps maintain viewer interest throughout the video.

Pro Tip: Use Multiple Clips

Instead of using a single long clip, try switching clips every few seconds.

This creates visual movement and keeps viewers engaged.

For example:

- 5–8 seconds per clip often works well.

This small technique can significantly improve viewer retention.

Instead of recording your own footage, you can quickly download professional-looking clips and combine them with your voiceover.
